Carpark

As you would have noticed our car park is currently being redeveloped. Thank you to everyone for the patience and consideration during this time. Car parking has been an issue for the school for a number of years. The reconfiguration of this area will mean a few changes:

- Firstly we will have extra parking spaces
- The current "Kiss and Drop" area will be extended and become a "Kiss and Drop" at all times. There will be no parking in this area at anytime
- In the "Kiss and Drop" area it would be beneficial if all parents could assist in the following ways:
 - Please stay in your car at all times.
 - $\circ~$ Encourage your children to be ready to get out of the car quickly in the mornings and look out for you in the afternoons
 - $\circ~$ Please pull up and stop as far up the Kiss and Drop zone as possible. We should be able to load and unload at least 6 vehicles at a time.
 - \circ $\,$ Only load and unload students in the kiss and drop zone.

Following these few simple rules will ensure the safety of everyone and the effective and efficient use of the carpark.

The carpark redevelopment is expected to continue until approximately week 5 this term, so if parents could continue to park in the surrounding streets of the Primary School the traffic in the carpark will remain at a minimum.
