**SPM FRIDAY 1st  
JULY**

Early bird discount is \$53 school-based days, \$65 for incursion, \$68 for excursion days. After that date an additional casual fee of \$5 per child per day is charged, if places are available.

# GENERAL INFORMATION

**PLEASE READ BELOW** vacation care general information. (booking, cancellation policies etc)

Please send your child with **RECESS, LUNCH, FRUIT & WATER BOTTLE** each day.

(Breakfast is available 7:30 – 8:30 AM)

It is recommended that you also send your child with a **CHANGE OF CLOTHES** for messy activities (or for little accidents).

**Enrolment:** All children must have an active enrolment on the QikKids Enrol Website. New families must go to the OSHC website and register to complete the online enrolment: <http://blackwoodps.sa.edu.au/oshc.html>

**Bookings:** Please note that all vacation care bookings **MUST** be made via the **My Family Lounge mobile phone app, and not the QK Enrol website**. Bookings made on the app will automatically be accepted. All bookings made for vacation care via the website will be invalid as the website bookings are only for ongoing permanent bookings for Before and After School Care. If you have any issues making bookings on the app, please email the OSHC Director to request bookings: [blackwood.oshc910@schools.sa.edu.au](mailto:blackwood.oshc910@schools.sa.edu.au) Casual bookings will also be accepted during Vacation Care if places are available. No bookings will be accepted on the day for excursion days unless spaces are available and parents/carers have called to enquire about bookings.

**Fee Payments:** A statement detailing fees, childcare subsidy and payments will be emailed each Tuesday for the previous week. Fees must be paid via Direct Debit. Failure to provide a completed Direct Debit form before vacation care commences may result in your bookings being cancelled. Regular OSHC fees must be up to date by the end of term, otherwise Vacation Care bookings may be cancelled.

**Fees:** Discounted fees apply if you book and pay during the EARLY BIRD ENROLMENT PERIOD. The fees during the Early Bird period are \$53.00 per child for a centre based day, \$65.00 per child for an incursion & \$68.00 excursion day. Excursion and Incursion days are clearly stated in the program. Casual Fees will be charged for bookings made after the Early Bird Period, which is \$58.00 per child for a centre based day \$70.00 per child for incursion days and \$73.00 for excursion days.

**LATE FEE:** \$20 per 15 minutes or part thereof, when children are collected after 6:00pm.

**CCS:** Childcare subsidy is available for eligible families who meet government requirements. It is the responsibility of families to contact Services Australia on 13 61 50, [www.servicesaustralia.gov.au/individuals/families](http://www.servicesaustralia.gov.au/individuals/families) (or call into Centrelink) to register their children for CCS. You must ensure all details are kept up to date on myGov, in particular, combined income. Families must provide Blackwood OSHC with the date of births and Centrelink reference numbers of their child(ren) and parent who registered for CCS. If this information is not provided you may be required to pay full fees until your CCS entitlements are confirmed.

**Signing IN / OUT:** Children must be escorted into the service and signed in by an authorised person. All authorised people to collect must use their **OWN phone number and personal pin number on the sign in/out iPad**. Please inform staff when arriving and leaving.

**Cancellation Policy:** A booking may only be cancelled upon presentation of a medical certificate (child or parent). If no medical certificate is provided for an absence you may change to another day during the same vacation care period providing availability OR the booking will be an allowable absence (Fees Charged and CCS deducted). Please mark your child absent on the app or phone by 8:30am, if your child/ren will be absent.

**Food and Drinks:** The service provides a nutritional breakfast (7:30 – 8:30am) and afternoon tea. Water is provided but children are encouraged to bring their own water bottle each day. Children must bring **recess and lunch each day**. Ensure an ice brick is placed in your child's lunch box. **Please do not send** food that needs reheating, cooking or hot water added, such as noodles. We have children attending our service that have been diagnosed as at risk of anaphylaxis due to Nut Allergy. Children and staff are not permitted to bring nuts or any products than contain nuts.

**Electronics & toys:** Electronic items such as mobile phones must be handed in for safe keeping. Smart watches must be placed on school mode during service hours. It is preferred that children do not bring their own toys from home, if they do it is at their own risk.

**Clothing and Personal Belongings:** Please ensure clothing is SunSmart and appropriate for planned activities and covers your child/ren's shoulders - No singlet or strap tops, as they are not considered SunSmart clothing. Please make sure your child/ren wear comfortable shoes which are appropriate for planned activities such as; sneakers and other enclosed footwear. NO thongs except for water-based activities E.G pool days, but also bring closed toe shoes for back at OSHC.

**Behaviour:** Children must follow the rules and procedures of Blackwood Primary OSHC. Consequences for inappropriate behaviour will be followed including discussions with parents, withdrawal from activities and reflection time. Inappropriate behaviour may result in exclusion from the service.

From the vacation care early bird deadline, there is no cancellation for bookings made. This policy is due to cost, planning, venue bookings and staff ratio requirements that must be undertaken in advanced. Through negotiation you may be able to swap a session to another day in the **SAME** vacation care period pending places available. If a medical certificate is provided within the week of absence, the booking may be cancelled by director/ assistant director.

## Please Note:

If your child/ren will not be attending a day, please ensure your child/ren are marked absent on the APP by 9AM on the day of absence.

If you have made an error with a booking please inform OSHC on day booking is made via email to discuss amending the booking.

The program may change at short notice due to covid restrictions, weather and unforeseen circumstances. Parents will be informed ASAP of these changes.
